# Seeking Research Participants for study on trauma

We are conducting a research study to examine the factors that explain the relationship between experiencing a traumatic event and the possibility of growth and/or positive outcomes following adversity. We are looking for participants to complete a quick online survey about a previous traumatic event that they have experienced. Trauma is defined as being exposed to death, threatened death, actual or threatened serious injury, or actual or threatened sexual violence, in the following way(s), direct exposure, witnessing the trauma, learning that a relative or close friend was exposed to a trauma, or indirect exposure to aversive details of the trauma, usually in the course of professional duties (e.g., first responders, medics).

The survey will take approximately 60 minutes of your time.

### Participants must

- ✓ Live in Toronto
- ✓ Range in age from 18-29 years
- ✓ Have experienced a traumatic event that occurred after the age of 12 but at least 1 year ago
